

## Projected Reduction in Children Served in Head Start Based on H.R. 1 – Fiscal Year 2011 Continuing Resolution

H.R. 1 would reduce funding for Head Start by \$1.08 billion, or 15 percent of current funding. This cut, coupled with the loss of ARRA funding, would cause 218,220 children to lose Head Start services.
