# **TANF** Reauthorization Recommendations

# **Relating to Child Welfare**

## • Focus on Poverty Reduction and Child Well-Being

- Include reduction of child poverty as a purpose of TANF.
- o Include a focus on the economic well-being of children.

### Provide Adequate Funding

- Maintain current TANF and MOE funding levels, with inflation adjustment.
- o Implement safeguards against supplantation.
- o Improve financial reporting by states.

### • Make Time Limits More Flexible

- Do not run the federal time clock when an adult in the family is employed and the family is receiving supplementary cash assistance.
- Do not apply federal time limits to families in which it is not reasonable to expect the adult to be employed; e.g. kinship caregivers.
- Eliminate the 20% cap on exceptions to federal time limits and allow states to specify the circumstances under which families can receive benefits after 60 months.

## Make Work Requirements More Flexible

- Permit states to design individual barrier removal plans and count satisfactory participation in those plans toward participation rates.
- o Permit states to exempt kinship caregivers from work requirements
- Implement procedures that ensure kinship care families receive needed services even when exempt from the work requirements.

### • Develop Safeguards To Prevent Inappropriate Sanctions

- Ensure that prior to the imposition of a sanction, the family is provided information and assistance about how to come into compliance.
- Ensure that after a sanction is imposed the family is contacted periodically and provided information and assistance about how to come into compliance.
- Ensure that sanctions end after a reasonable period of compliance.

### Require Additional Information in State Plans

- Include description of how kinship care families will be served
- o Include description of how "dual system" families will be served.
- Include description of how TANF agency will work with other agencies to address families' barriers to employment.
- o Include description of what activities count towards participation.

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
