

**Good news! New health coverage for adults is coming.**

On January 1, 2019, Virginia Medicaid will offer new health coverage for adults. Because you are currently receiving Plan First benefits, and based on your reported income, you will be enrolled in this new coverage.

**You do not need to apply.** To make it as easy as possible for you to receive your new benefits, we will handle the enrollment for you. Look for more information about your new health benefits in the mail.

**This is what will happen next:**

1. You will receive an official notice that you have been approved for Medicaid.
2. You will receive a new blue and white Medicaid ID card. After 1/1/19 you will no longer need the green and white Plan First card.
3. Most members will get their health care from Medicaid health plans. You will receive information about the health plan you have been assigned to and how you can change to a different plan if you choose. You may wish to talk to your doctor or health care providers about which Medicaid health plans they participate in.
4. You may start using your new benefits January 1, 2019.

These new benefits will include many more services. You will be covered for services such as:

- Doctor, hospital and emergency services, including primary and specialty care
- Prescription drugs
- Laboratory and X-ray services
- Maternity and newborn care
- Home health services
- Behavioral health services, including addiction and recovery treatment services
- Rehabilitative services, including physical, occupational and speech therapies
- Family planning services
- Medical equipment and supplies
- Preventative and wellness services
- And more!
