

## WIOA Title II Adult Education & Family Literacy Act

The President’s budget proposes **\$485,800,000** for WIOA Title II AEFLA, a **16%** cut to the program from current funding levels. Below is an estimate of how much WIOA Title II AEFLA funding each state will lose under the President’s proposal. <sup>1</sup>
