

Good news! New health coverage for adults is coming.

On January 1, 2019, Virginia Medicaid will offer new health coverage for adults. Since you are a current GAP member, you will be enrolled in this new coverage.

You do not need to apply. To make it as easy as possible for you to receive your new benefits, we will handle the enrollment for you.

This is what will happen next:

1. You will receive an official notice that you have been approved for Medicaid.
2. You will receive a blue and white Medicaid ID card
3. Most members will get their health care from Medicaid health plans. You will receive information about the health plan you have been assigned to and how you can change to a different plan if you choose. You may wish to talk to your doctor or health care providers about which Medicaid health plans they participate in.
4. Your new health plan will provide a Care Coordinator, a person to help you get the care you need.

On January 1, 2019 you will have all the benefits you have now and more services will be covered now. Your Medicaid will cover the following:

- Doctor, hospital and emergency services, including primary and specialty care
- Prescription drugs
- Laboratory and X-ray services
- Maternity and newborn care
- Home health services
- Behavioral health services, including addiction and recovery treatment services
- Rehabilitative services, including physical, occupational and speech therapies
- Family planning services
- Medical equipment and supplies
- Preventative and wellness services
- And much more!
